**CAFOD NEWS:** Boris Johnson is getting ready to host some of the world's most powerful leaders at a meeting in Cornwall in just a couple of weeks' time. It will be a big moment, one which will see the heads of government from the G7 group of countries – including President Biden – travel to the UK to work on plans for how we rebuild from the pandemic. But Pope Francis has warned that people in the world's poorest communities are too often forgotten by decision makers – so we want to tell the G7 leaders that they have to plan for a global recovery which leaves no one behind.
